

# School Health Services

## About the Service

This service is provided for school students where a set of clinical and laboratory tests are conducted for school students according to targeted age groups. This enables the early detection of sickness and receive the required vaccinations.

## Service Process

- In the annual examination for a student from kindergarten to grade 12, the school clinic nurse will: Determine height and weightCalculate body massPerform an eye examination
- Kindergarten stage: Student visits the doctor for clinical examination
- Grade 1: Student visits the doctor for clinical examinationA full blood test will be performed for all students (male and female)A preventive dental examination will be performed
- Grade 5: Student visits the doctor for clinical examination
- Grade 9: Student visits the doctor for clinical examinationA blood test will be performed for females

## Required Documents

- Student health file documented at the school clinic
- A valid Health Card

## Conditions & Requirements

1. The student must be enrolled in a public school in Dubai, Sharjah, Ajman, Umm Al Quwain, Ras Al Khaimah or Fujairah
